Life Experiences Subcommittee

For purposes of the 2026 interim, the Life Experiences Subcommittee adopts a life-course frame that moves from reproductive autonomy and fertility to pregnancy, postpartum care, caregiving, safety, midlife, and menopause. The subcommittee's work may include reproductive and sexual health, fertility and fertility preservation, pregnancy and prenatal care, maternal morbidity and mortality, postpartum health, pregnancy loss and infant loss, infant and fetal mortality review, menstrual health, caregiving, and care workforce issues, child care and family economic security, safety from domestic violence, sexual assault, and trafficking, midlife health, menopause and perimenopause, and related workplace, insurance, public health, and access-to-care issues.

The subcommittee may receive testimony, review failed, continued, incorporated, pending, or recently enacted legislation, request agency briefings, examine implementation of enacted measures, develop best-practice or model-policy recommendations, and identify legislative or budget recommendations for the 2027 Session. To avoid overlap, each agenda item shall be assigned a lead workgroup, named consulting workgroup, and a referral trigger if the issue becomes a primarily preventative care, later-life aging policy, or technology infrastructure.
